

Pocso case: Police summon min's son

THE Pet Basheerabad police on Tuesday summoned Bandi Sai Bhageerath (23), son of Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Bandi Sanjay Kumar, in connection with a case registered under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO Act), and directed him to appear before investigators on Wednesday. Hours earlier, Bhageerath moved the Telangana High Court seeking anticipatory bail in connection with the case.

The notice, served to his ma-

ternal uncle Ch Vamshi Krishna, instructed him to produce Bhageerath before the Pet Basheerabad inspector by 2 pm on Wednesday for examination and investigation. "Please note that failure to comply with this notice may result in legal action being initiated against you in accordance with law," the notice stated.

According to the petition, the FIR dated May 8, 2026 was initially registered at the Pet Basheerabad Police Station under Sections 74 (criminal force to woman with intent to outrage modesty) and 75 (sexual harassment) of the BNS, along with Section 11 read with Section 12 of the POCSO Act dealing with

sexual harassment and non-penetrative acts involving sexual intent.

Police later altered the charges based on the victim's statement and invoked Section 5(1) read with Section 6 of the POCSO Act relating to aggravated penetrative sexual assault. Section 6 of the Act prescribes punishment ranging from a minimum of 20 years' imprisonment to life imprisonment or death.

According to the complaint lodged by the mother of a 17-year-old girl, Bhageerath allegedly subjected the minor to "a sustained pattern of grooming, emotional manipulation and sexual exploitation" beginning in June 2025.

TVK banners obstruct public spaces in Coimbatore, irk residents, motorists

MOTORISTS and residents across the district have voiced concerns over the increasing number of illegal banners and hoardings put up by the members of Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam (TVK), alleging that the display boards are obstructing public spaces and posing safety risks to road users.

One such display board has been installed in front of the rest lounge for gig workers on Sanganoor Road. The banner, which features TVK's top functionaries and Coimbatore North MLA Sambath Kumar thanking voters for the latter's victory, has blocked the entrance to the facility, which has a portrait of former chief minister M K Stalin, making access difficult for delivery personnel and gig workers.

Residents and commuters alleged that similar banners have sprung up across several parts of the city, including near bus stops and along busy roads. Many have pointed out that such display boards not only affect traffic flow but are also potential hazards for road users,

The issue has sparked criticism among a few sections of the public, especially as the party had projected itself as a political alternative promising change and better governance. DMK-AIADMK tie-up simply rumours, says R S Bharathi

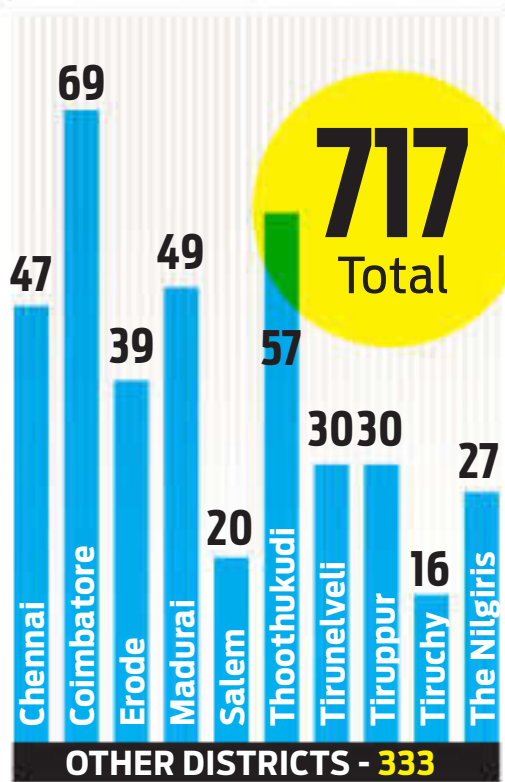
CHENNAI: Responding to the allegations by AIADMK leader C Ve Shanmugam that there were talks of a possible political arrangement between the two Dravidian parties, DMK organising secretary RS Bharathi dismissed them as rumours and speculation.

Bharathi said that former DMK president MK Stalin had clarified on the day of the result that DMK would function as an "exemplary opposition party".

"The very next day, he also went to his constituency Kolathur and thanked the people. He immediately convened DMK MLAs meeting at the party office and elected the party's legislative leader, deputy leader and the whip," he said, adding DMK in its journey of over 70 years has created records both in terms of victories and defeats. "DMK alliance had won in 221 of the 234 seats and created history, which no party could touch until now. Similarly, we just won only one seat in 1991. We neither danced in frenzy at the sight of victory, nor lost heart in the face of defeat. DMK works continuously for the people irrespective of the electoral outcome," he said. He alleged that the former AIADMK minister is making such allegations as a ruse to seek power. "C Ve Shanmugam is known for powermongering," he said, and questioned whether Vijay was looking to break a section of AIADMK for his own benefit. "Is he now breaking up one of the two parties and adding them to his cabinet?" he asked.

THE Tamil Nadu Liquor Retail Vending (in Shops and Bars) Rules, 2003, had so far mandated the closure of liquor shops situated within 50m (in urban areas) and 100m (in rural areas) from educational institutions and places of worship. The order now extends the restriction limit to 500m. Officials added that staff in the closed outlets will be accommodated in the remaining functioning ones.

TN Tasmac Workers Association general secretary T Dhanasekar urged the government to also identify and shut FL2 licensed bars and recreation clubs functioning within 500m of educational institutions, places of worship and bus depots. "The government announcement has not mentioned FL2 licensed bars. If such bars are also closed, the objective of the government's move will be fully achieved. There are 1,497 FL2 licensed holders across the state" he added.

Trekking in Velliangiri hills banned from tomorrow

Coimbatore: Officials of the Coimbatore forest division have announced that devotees will be permitted to climb Velliangiri Hills only until Wednesday evening. Typically, pilgrims are allowed to undertake the trek from February 1 until the end of May. A forest official said that the restriction was imposed considering the safety of devotees in view of the ongoing rainfall in the area, as the terrain tends to get slippery. ENS

We have no intention to split AIADMK: Velumani

MLAs S P Velumani and G Hari have been elected as the leader and deputy leader of the legislature party.

"We have no intention to split the AIADMK. We are only concerned about the party," Velumani said.

Countering this, on behalf of the MLAs supporting EPS, MLA and former minister O S Manian said they had letters of all 47 AIADMK MLAs declaring support to Palaniswami as the general secretary and as the leader of the legislature party. "Their desire to attain positions of power is making them (the Shanmugam faction) speak in such a manner," he charged. Manian

said 26 MLAs accompanied their team when they met the pro-tem speaker.

Agri S S Krishnamurthy, whip of the EPS group, said a whip has been issued to all 47 MLAs to vote against the TVK government on Wednesday during the trust vote.

"If they violate this, legal action will be taken," he added. After the Secretariat episode, both AIADMK factions visited the memorial of late Chief Minister J Jayalalithaa and offered prayers.

Meanwhile, NDA ally AMMK's lone MLA, S Kamaraj, while felicitating the newly-elected Speaker J C D Prabhakar, announced his support

for the TVK government. Following this, the party's general secretary, T T V Dhinakaran, expelled Kamaraj from the party.

As he is AMMK's lone MLA, Kamaraj's support to TVK won't invoke the anti-defection law.

Asked about the two AIADMK groups naming separate floor leaders and whips, former speaker M Appavu of the DMK said the final call on recognising the AIADMK legislature party and office-bearers rests with the speaker, whose decision can only be challenged in court.

Appavu said disqualification would not arise if the rival faction had the support of

two-thirds of the AIADMK MLAs, allowing them to function separately or even merge with another party. In the absence of such a majority, the speaker would have to decide the issue, he said, noting that EPS had issued Form-B and the party symbol to all the candidates.

Another former speaker, P Dhanapal, who belongs to AIADMK but is not in active politics, said action could be taken against MLAs who vote against the party line or leadership only after the legislature party leader and chief whip are elected, adding that, with both AIADMK factions staking a claim, the final decision rests with the speaker under prescribed guidelines.

Two held for keeping aluminium ladder on railway track

Coimbatore: Two persons were arrested by the RPF for allegedly placing an aluminium ladder on the railway track between Coimbatore North and Peelamedu railway stations to break it into pieces using an oncoming train, so they could sell it as scrap. The incident occurred on May 9 afternoon, when the suspects - Nagaraj (35) of Veera Keralam and Kandasamy (45) of Karamadai - kept the ladder on the tracks and an express train ran over it, breaking it into pieces. The train, which was immediately halted, resumed after the pieces were cleared from the track. On May 10, the RPF Coimbatore team, along with the Crime Intelligence Branch, detained the suspects, who were subsequently booked under the Railways Act and arrested. ENS
