

Vijay's crop loan bonanza: Complete waiver up to ₹75K

CHIEF Minister C Joseph Vijay on Tuesday announced a revised crop loan waiver scheme under which all marginal, small, and large farmers who availed crop loans up to ₹75,000 from cooperative banks would receive a full waiver. Those who borrowed more than ₹75,000 would be eligible for a waiver of ₹35,000. The scheme will benefit 14.43 lakh farmers who obtained crop loans from cooperative banks between May 1, 2025, and February 28, 2026.

On May 25, the government had announced a waiver of loans up to ₹50,000 for marginal farmers and a 50% waiver on loans up to ₹50,000 for small farmers. Large farmers with crop loans of up to ₹1 lakh were eligible for a waiver of ₹5,000. However, a section of farmers staged protests demanding a complete waiver of crop loans for those holding up to five acres and a 50% waiver for farmers owning more than five acres, in line with the promise made in the TVK election manifesto.

Following this, the CM chaired a review meeting on Monday and asked ministers and senior officials to restructure the scheme. Under the re-

vised scheme, the financial burden on the state exchequer will rise from ₹2,044 crore to ₹5,932 crore. The number of beneficiaries has increased to 14.43 lakh from about 14.22 lakh.

According to an official statement, the waiver will enable farmers to access fresh crop loans for the upcoming cultivation season. Crop loans amounting to ₹3,058.06 crore availed by 6,22,313 farmers with borrowings of up to ₹75,000 will be waived in full. The beneficiaries include 5.22 lakh marginal farmers, 94,427 small farmers, and 4,753 large farmers.

Additionally, around 8.21 lakh farmers with loans exceeding ₹75,000 will receive a waiver of ₹35,000 each, covering loans worth ₹2,874 crore. These beneficiaries include about 3.10 lakh marginal farmers, 4.21 lakh small farmers, and 88,795 large farmers. In total, crop loans amounting to ₹5,932.23 crore taken by 14,43,504 farmers will be waived under the scheme, the statement said. It also noted that, in accordance with Reserve Bank of India guidelines, the dues payable to cooperative banks under the waiver scheme would be settled by the state government within 45 to 60 days.

CHEATING Owners of FIITJEE, pvt school booked

THE City police have registered a cheating case against the Chairman of Suguna PIP School V Lakshmi Narayanasamy, and FIITJEE founder Dinesh Kumar Goyal following complaints by parents who alleged that they had been duped of refundable caution deposits from parents.

According to the complaint filed by DG Vikram from Vattamalaipalayam, he enrolled his son in the integrated NEET/JEE coaching programme jointly offered by Suguna PIP School and FIITJEE in 2023. He paid a ₹1 lakh refundable caution deposit, with the school and coaching institute on promise of the money being returned within 60 days of course completion.

The course ended in February 2025, but despite repeated requests, the money was not refunded. School authorities allegedly directed parents to approach FIITJEE, while the latter remained unresponsive. The affected parents jointly approached the police in November, 2025. After an investigation, Peelamedu police registered a case under Section 420 (cheating) of the IPC against the two individuals. Parents said that as many as 262 parents had each paid ₹1 lakh as caution deposit, and none have received refunds so far.

Safety infra to be improved on lake bund road

THE brutal sexual assault and murder of a minor girl near Kannampalayam Lake has triggered widespread outrage in Sullur, with residents raising concerns over safety on the lake bund road that connects Pallapalayam and surrounding villages where the incident took place.

Locals said the bund road is a major link for residents in Pallapalayam and nearby villages, with heavy pedestrian and vehicle movement throughout the day. But the stretch remains poorly maintained and lacks basic safety infrastructure, leaving it vulnerable to crime, especially during the night.

In the wake of the incident and following the concerns over basic safety measures, the Sullur MLA NM Sukumar said that the state government has sanctioned ₹1.70 crore special funds to the infrastructure development. "The road is used by school children and women every day. There are no streetlights and no cameras. It becomes deserted and unsafe at

night," said a resident from the Pallapalayam village.

Responding to the concerns, Sullur MLA NM Sukumar said he has sought special funds from the state government for the development of the Kannampalayam Lake bund road. The proposal includes installation of around 24 streetlights and strengthening of the bund road. "The safety of our people is paramount. We have requested funds specifically for lighting and road works for around two kilometres on the stretch," Sukumar said.

Meanwhile, the Kannampalayam Town Panchayat has begun removing bushes on the lake bund road. Sources said that the road work will be initiated after the earth works.

College student robbed, held hostage by five-member gang

KUNIAMUTHUR police are on the lookout for a five-member gang that allegedly assaulted, robbed gold, and demanded ₹2 lakh ransom by wrongfully confining a 19-year-old college student at a rented house in Kuniamuthur.

According to police, the victim — R Kesavan, a native of Virudhunagar district — is a third-year B Com student at a private college in Kuniamuthur and has been staying at a rented house. On Sunday evening, Kesavan visited the house after his roommate

called him, but the five suspects, including Salaga alias Aakash and Pandi, were already present.

The police said that Pandi allegedly hit Kesavan with a metal rod on his shoulder and a knife on his back. The gang then snatched the victim's two-sovereign gold chain and confined him in the room. They allegedly demanded the victim, and later his relatives, a ransom of ₹2 lakh. When the police reached the location on Monday, the gang jumped off the first floor, and escaped. They also stole a motorcycle by threatening its rider.

BU to appoint 60 guest lecturers by end of June

BHARATHIAR University has initiated the process to fill 60 vacant posts through Guest Lecturers (GL) in its departments by the end of this month to ensure uninterrupted academic activities in the 2026-27 academic year.

University Registrar R Rajavel told *TNIE* that classes for postgraduate students

will commence on July 1.

"We have initiated the recruitment process to fill 60 vacant guest lecturer posts in 39 departments for the current academic year. The process began on Monday, with a monthly salary of ₹25,000. Applications will be invited and interviews completed by June 27. Following approval by the Syndicate, the selected candidates will join duty on July 1," he said.

EARLIER, Maragatham Kumavel (Madurantakam), S Jayakumar (Perundurai) and P Sathyabama (Dharapuram) and Esakki Subbairah (Ambasamuthiram) resigned their posts and later joined the TVK. Vijayabaskar's resignation comes amid continuing unrest within the AIADMK. Over the past two days, he had openly criticised the party leadership, raising questions about the direction of the party.

Hours before submitting his resignation, Vijayabaskar posted a message on 'X', taking

an indirect swipe at AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami. Without naming EPS, Vijayabaskar said the leadership should be based on care, dedication and trust, and not on authority or arrogance.

He also said a leadership that fails to earn the trust and affection of party workers cannot win the support of the people.

Following his resignation, the former minister shared an emotional statement on 'X', and recalled dedicating more than 35 years of his life to the party founded by former CM

MG Ramachandran and drawing inspiration from former chief minister J Jayalalitha, since his student days. He described the AIADMK as not just a political party, but a part of his identity and life.

However, he said the party he loved deeply is now facing difficulties because of the "wrong decisions of an individual". He said continuing his journey under such circumstances would not be right. "With a heavy heart and deep pain, I am leaving this great movement. I am not leaving just a political party, but a chapter of my life," he added.

PSU losses can be described as man-made disaster: Minister

ANSWERING another question, Finance Minister N Marie Wilson said, "We chose the post-pandemic period since all states are in the same position. The losses in PSUs can be described as man-made disaster."

Replying to a question about the 'leakages in the revenue resources', the minister said, "Last year, everyone knows what has happened. For example, in Anna Nagar, the market value of land is ₹25,000 per square foot, it was

influenced to undervalue the market value using guideline value. Hence, leakages happened. So, everything depends on clean administration." When pointed out that the TVK government has not spoken about fulfilling their election promises given to the people except for reiterating that they would provide clean government, the minister said, "We are very clear in our approach. Definitely whatever promised to the people will be fulfilled with a timeline."
